



Getting Started at Western Cape Off-Road club & MSA.

Step 1: Club Membership

Complete the membership form available on www.racecontrol.co.za

2021 Membership fees (R 625 – Adults, R 415 for under 18)

Email completed form with proof of payment to clubsecretary@wco racing.co.za

Once you have your club membership you need to get an MSA License

Step 2: MSA License

Go to <https://www.msaonline.co.za/>

- a. Register
- b. Medical Declaration –
 - a. if you are over 50 and you hold a National or International License, you will need to submit an ECG test to MSA every 5 years before your medical declaration will be approved so this is a 2 day process.
 - b. If you are on any chronic medicine, your declaration will stay pending – email Rashaad@motorsport.co.za with a list of medicine/conditions and he will approve your medical declaration after which you can continue
- c. Complete Indemnity
- d. Declare club joined in step 1 – for this you will need to be a member of ANY MSA Affiliated Club
- e. Purchase
 - a. Select type (I.e. cross country – You can ride offroad/enduro and MX with this license. Also specify if it's a club/Regionals/National License. This will depend on the class you ride and if it falls under a club or regional class)
 - i. Club: R634
 - b. Select medical insurance (minimum R 528)
- f. Pay for license (R 1162 for an Annual license to ride all the Offroad/Enduro/MX)

Step 3: Bike Number & Number Board Colours

Contact Carmen at MSA to secure a bike number.

2021 – MSA WOW LICENCE

The WOW (Weekend Off-road Warrior) license is aimed at introducing recreational riders to MSA events. This is not a championship class and intended to introduce new comers to Racing. Listed below are the broad details concerning these licenses:

- The license will be R122 per event
- No credit will be granted against the cost of an annual license should a rider decide to upgrade to a regular MSA license during the course of the year. The full cost of the annual license, as well as the cost of any associated personal accident insurance purchase/upgrade, will be payable in such instances.
- Competitors with regular MSA licenses (annual or one event) cannot enter the WOW class. Any such rider who incorrectly enters the WOW class will not be scored in the dedicated WOW Log that MSA will maintain.
- You can ONLY purchases three (3) one event WOW licenses.
- MSA personal accident insurance cover is not mandatory for WOW license holders but riders who elect not to take out MSA cover will be required to satisfy event organizers (and therefore the medical teams at events) that they have their own personal accident insurance/medical aid so as not to be referred to public hospitals in the event of an accident.

4. Sign up for a race event

The link for the race entries will be made public as soon as the race entries open around 2 weeks before a race. Please ensure that you follow our social media pages and is at least on one of the communication groups.

5. What to take with

- COVID Daily Screening form for each person entering the venue.
- Fire extinguisher - min capacity **2.5 Kg** per competitor.
- Environmental mat - Min 50cm square. Old piece of PVC or Tarpaulin will do.
- Medical kits – For sale at event.
- Medical board – For sale at event.
- Hydration Pack.

6. Pit Lane

- No speeding in the pit lane - Idling speed.
- No overtaking in pit lane unless someone is struggling with a mechanical issue in front of you.
- No refueling while sitting on bike/quad (penalty is exclusion).
- No smoking in pit area
- No fires in pit area
- No alcohol consumption in pit lane
- No practice riding around the pit area – this leads to accidents!

7. General race etiquette

- When caught by another competitor – let him/her past
- Stop at road crossing or any Stop sign place by the organizers – stop 100% stationary and only proceed when safe to do so (penalty is exclusion). This will be monitored.
- Stop to assist an injured competitor.
- Report any incidents of concern – such as fire / flooding etc...
- Ride within your means and **full control** of your machine.
- Do not venture onto the route to fetch someone or broken bike without the COC permission.
- Report to the medics if you have fallen – very important, you cannot claim later if you did not register with the medics at the event!
- Under No Circumstances can you change direction (Turn around) during the race at any time.
